The judges will be comprised of the B - W Executive Board. The judges will consider the following (1) High School grades (2) extra curricular activities (3) Scholarship Application essay (4) financial need and (5) thoroughness of the completed Application.

How do I Apply ??

What must accompany the Application ??

- (1) A Transcript of High School grades through the most recent marking period up to April 30, 2025 if possible.
- (2) A letter of recommendation from a member of the High School Faculty. This letter should include the number of students in the Graduating Class and the current standing of the Applicant.
- (3) A letter of recommendation from a member of a Community Organization (i.e., Boy Scouts, Church, Recreation Department, etc.) highlighting the Applicant's contribution to the Community.

When must I apply ??

All Applications must be submitted on or before May 01, 2025. The recipient of this Scholarship will be notified by early to mid June, 2025.
